

STREET CLOCKS

TWO DIAL POST CLOCK - 1863

Movement to be placed in building, and connection made under sidewalk. Iron column. 15 feet to center of dial. Dial, 40 inches.

POST CLOCK MOVEMENT - 1907

The movement used in street clocks is similar to No. 4 eight-day weight tower clock, compact and powerful.

TWO DIAL POST CLOCK No. 3 - 1907

Dials, 30 and 40 inches in diameter, covered with plate-glass to protect the hands from the snow and ice. At either side of the head are water-tight doors, so that access can be had for replacing the lights when necessary.

TWO DIAL POST CLOCK No. 4 - 1907

Dials made of the best plate-glass three-eighths of an inch thick, ground on both sides. The numerals and minute dots painted on the surface in black or gold leaf. Can be fitted with suitable advertising signs.
